### Case 1

# 20 Year Old Girl with Bilateral Decrease in Vision Over Few Months

## HISTORY

20 year-old girl who presented with decreased visual acuity noticed mainly over the previous few months during night driving. She has no other ocular complaints, and she has no previous medical history. Family history is negative for ocular or medical diseases.

## EXAMINATION

Vision 6/12 OU

Normal anterior segment.

Fundus: Multiple small shiny refractile bodies over posterior pole.



## DIFFERENTIAL DIAGNOSIS

Bietti's Corneoretinal Dystrophy or Crystalline Retinopathy

Particulate Retinopathy

Drug- Induced Crystalline Maculopathy: Methoxyflurane (Ca-oxalate) Retinopathy

Tamoxiphen Maculopathy

Pseudoretinitis Pigmentosa
